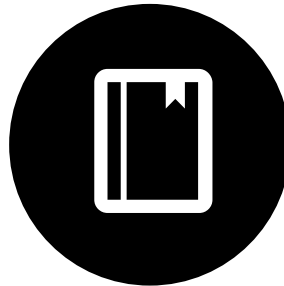

### Follow these five steps to send work for evaluation.




